DAGESTAN: The poorest republic in the Russian Federation, next door to Chechnya, is 94 percent Muslim and the people are in great need of our prayers. Muslim groups are violently bent on making Dagestan an Islamic Republic. Pray earnestly for Christian believers that they would not be intimidated by the warnings, threats, abuse or persecution. Pastor Will Sohnchen Sermon Outline - August 1st, 2010 "Wise Up" – Part 1

A proverb is a form of communicating truth by using "*comparisons or figures of speech.*"

The biblical proverbs are also written as poetry and Hebrew poetry is structured quite different from English poetry. English poetry most often uses rhyme and rhythm while Hebrew poetry is structured around "parallelism and intensification." Thus the second line of the poem intensifies the first.

*"Blessed is the man who finds wisdom,
 the man who gains understanding."
 Proverbs 3:13*

Where does this wisdom begin?

*"The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom
 but fools despise wisdom and discipline".
 Proverbs 1:7*

How is this wisdom proven?

*16"To what can I compare this generation? They are like children sitting in the marketplaces and calling out to others: 17" 'We played the flute for you, and you did not dance; we sang a dirge and you did not mourn.' 18For John came neither eating nor drinking, and they say, 'He has a demon.' 19The Son of Man came eating and drinking, and they say, 'Here is a glutton and a drunkard, a friend of tax collectors and "sinners." ' But wisdom is proved right by her actions."
